

## ***Phase One Plants for Audubon Bird and Butterfly Garden at Bishop Community Demonstration Garden***

(The plants on this list are the ones you saw planted in the demonstration. All of them love sun!)

### ***Plants Hummingbirds love!***

- Penstemon- Strictus, Skagit, any kind except white
- Kniphofia- Torch Flower, Echo Rojo, (Bullock's and Hooded Orioles love these!)
- Salvia-Greggii, Burgundy Candles,

### ***Plants Butterflies love!***

- Buddleja- Miss Ruby
- Sedum-Pink Chablis, Autumn Delight, Xenox
- Gaillardia-any kind (Goldfinches love the seeds)
- Shasta Daisy-Gold Rush
- Lavender (Goldfinches love the seeds)
- Milkweed

### ***Plants Butterflies and Hummingbirds love!***

- Agastache-Blue Blazes Hyssop
- Scabiosa- Butterfly Blue Pincushion Flower
- Himalayan Leptodermis
- Catmint (Goldfinches love the seeds)

### ***Fruit bearing plants for Residents and Migrants***

- Sea Berry-You need at least two plants, female and male. Fruit is good for humans too!

### ***Cover Plants for winter visitors and migrants***

- Roses-Iceberg

### ***Owens Valley Natives***

- Ceanothus, Fernbush, Mountain Mahogany, Desert Peach, Bitterbrush. Some of these are planted in the Native Plant section of the Demonstration Garden.

## ***Audubon Bird and Butterfly Garden Plant List***

### ***Plants chosen to attract hummingbirds and butterflies and like SUN, my favorites!***

- *Salvia gregorii*
- Kniphofia (Torch Flower or Red hot poker)
- Penstemons
- Butterfly bush
- Screen to hide compost bin – Iceberg Rose, Sea Berry
- Tithonia - Mexican sunflower
- *Salvia pachyphylla*

### ***Plants that like less water and not so rich soils***

- Agastache 'Desert Solstice' (Hybrid Humming bird mint)
- Agastache 'Desert Sunrise' (Hybrid Humming bird mint)
- *Agastache neomexicana*
- *Asclepias tuberosa* 'Western Gold Mix' (a butterfly weed)
- *Coreopsis lanceolata* 'Sterntaler'
- *Gaillardia grandiflora* 'Arizona Red'
- *Gaillardia grandiflora* 'Arizona Sun'
- Gazania 'Butterscotch Baby'
- *Lavandula angustifolia* 'Sharon Roberts'
- Penstemon *Mexicali* 'Pike's Peak Purple'
- *Ratibida columifera* 'Mexican Hat' (prairie Coneflower)
- *Salvia greggii* 'Furman's Red'
- Salvia 'Burgundy Seduction'
- *Salvia dorrii* 'Desert Purple Sage'
- Salvia 'Ultra Violet'
- Sedum 'Thundercloud' (Thundercloud Dwarf Sedum)

### ***Plants that like more water and rich soils***

- Agastache 'Ava'
- *Echinacea purpurea* 'Red Star'
- Geranium 'Rozzanne' (Rozzanne Hardy Geranium)
- Monarda 'Fireball'
- Monarda 'Violet Queen'
- *Penstemon barbatus* 'Rubycunda'

### ***Plants that will most likely grow anywhere***

- *Achillea filpendulina* 'Gold Plate' (Yarrow)
- *Berlandiera lyrata* 'Mora County Mix' (Extra Cold Hearty Chocolate Flower)
- Buddleia (Butterfly Bush)
- *Echinops banaticus* 'Blue Glow'
- *Rudbeckia fulgida* 'Golstrum' (Black Eyed Susan)
- *Salvia sylvestris* 'Blue Hill Sage'
- *Salvia azurea* (prairie Sage, New Mexico form)
- *Stachys lavadulifolius* 'Pink Cotton Lamb's Ear'

### ***Vines for fence***

- Clematis, Hyacinth Bean, *Lonicera reticulata* (Kintzley's Ghost Vining Honeysuckle)
