Descriptions are details imbedded in an observer's report and are not forwarded with the county report. Descriptions are noted behind the observer's initials and can be sent on request.

Documentation is a separate account included with the observer's report. If it is a CBRC review species it is forwarded electronically, concurrent with the mailing of the report, if not earlier. Documentation is required for many species in Inyo County that are more commonly found elsewhere in the southern CA region. If documentation does not accompany a bird seen in Inyo County that is rare or more unusual, it will not be considered a county record or submitted for publication. Documentation is noted behind the observer's initials and can be sent on request if not submitted with this report.

Numerous sightings of Inyo birds were posted on the Internet without any description and are not included in the report or the county database. Other posts contained adequate descriptions and/or photographs and are included in this report and in the county database.
